

11<sup>th</sup> December, 2021, NSS Volunteers cleaned their Unit Room and Front Garden and planted some garden flowering plants.



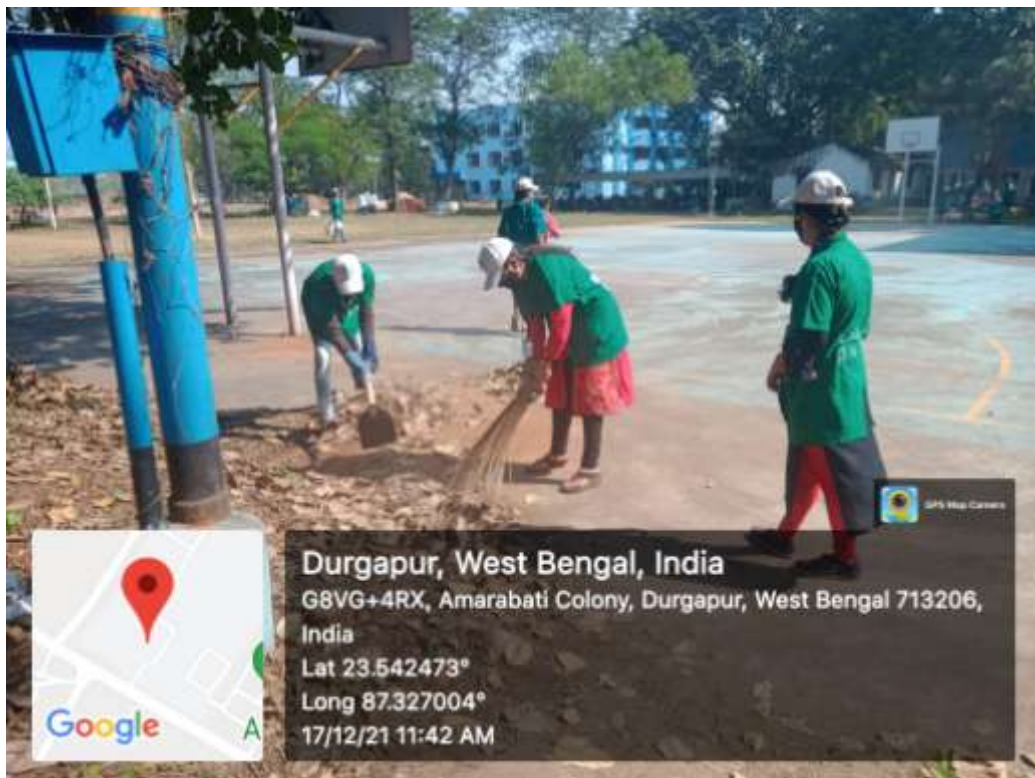

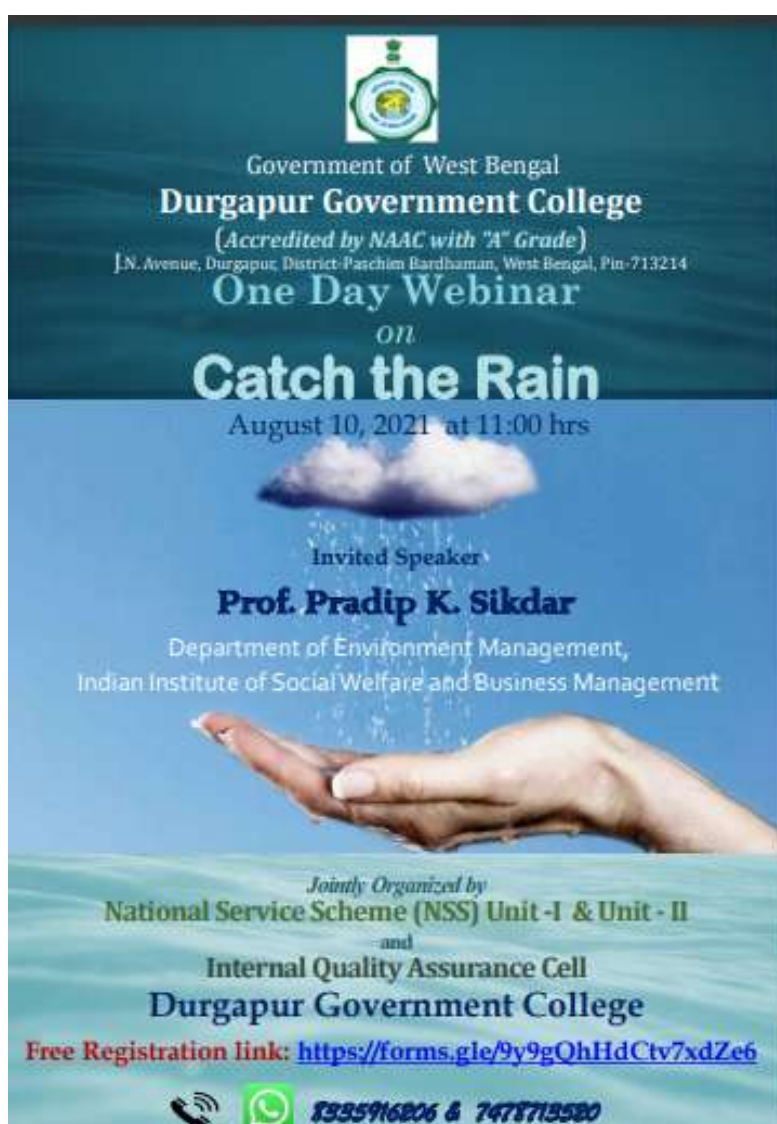

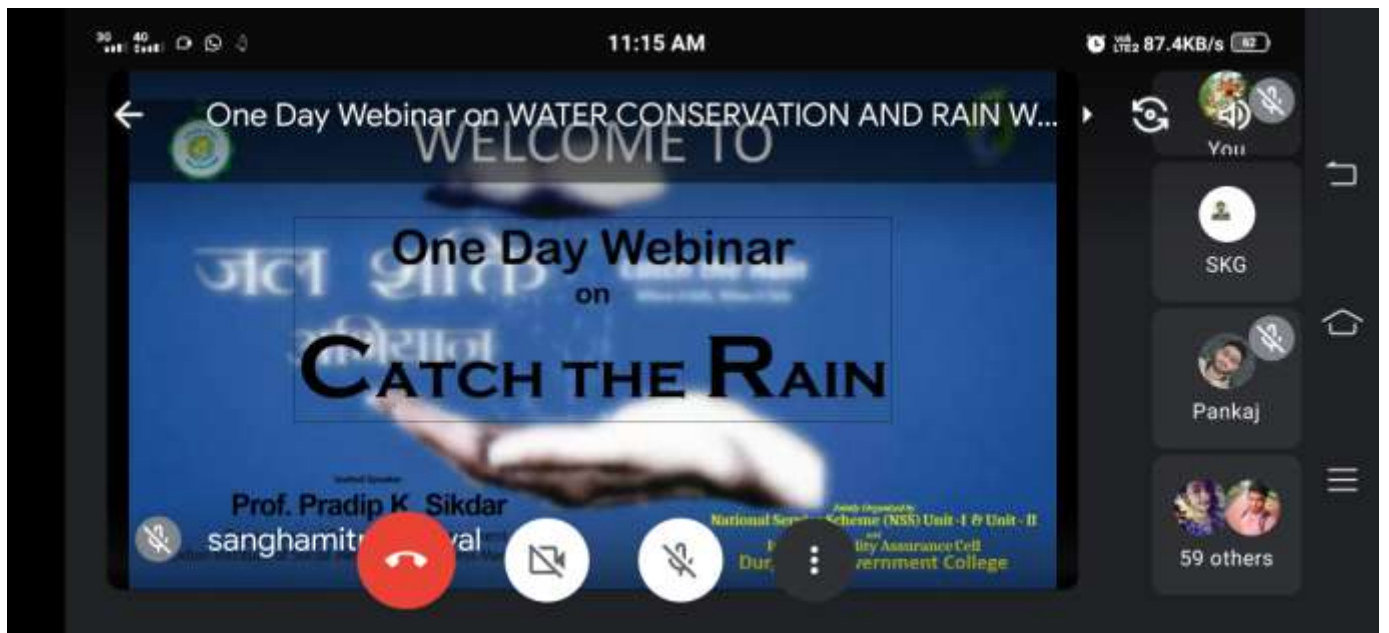
### **Webinar on "Catch the Rain" organized by NSS Unit, Durgapur Government College**

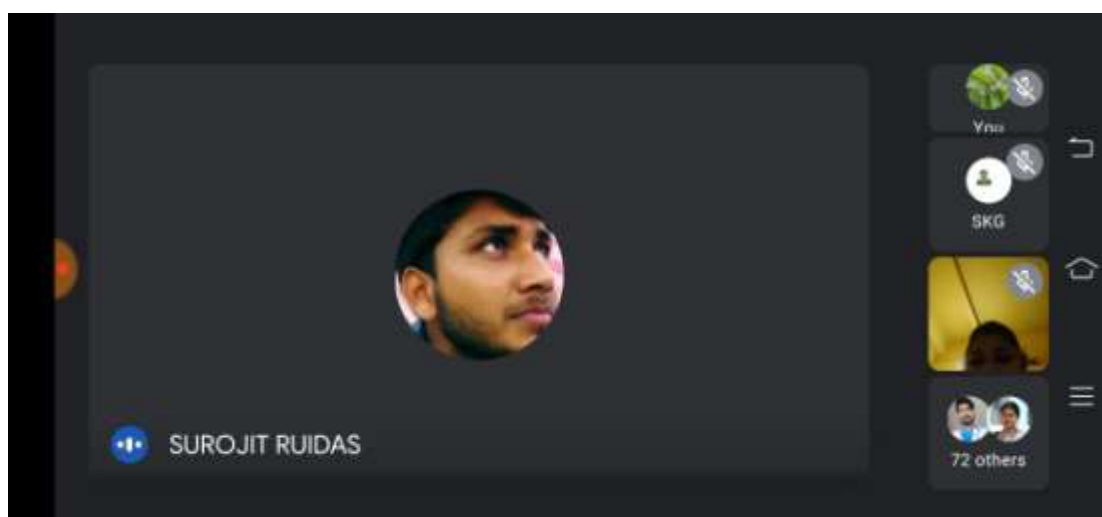

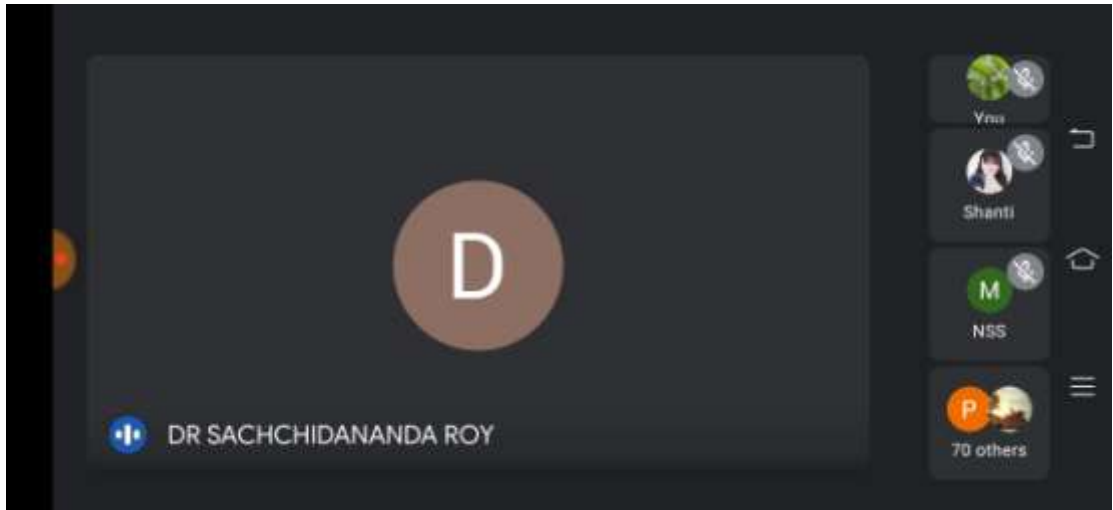


## Webinar on Role of NSS Volunteers
