NSS Units

NSS wing of the institution is very active since its opening in 1972 and has a very glorious past. NSS has two units with volunteer belonging to Science, Arts and Commerce streams. Unit 1 was opened in 1972 and Unit 2 was opened in the year 2008.

Adopted villages

Uttarpally is the adopted village under unit-1. Unit -2 has adopted Dangapara, a new village since the academic year 2015-2016. Some NSS volunteers of our college are recruited from these adopted villages and in most of the cases they are first generation learners. Especially these volunteers are entrusted with the responsibility to sustain the development of these adopted villages after their pass-out.

Awareness regarding State and Central Government schemes and facilities, health, cleaning environment and education awareness programme are carried throughout the year. NSS volunteers work sincerely to ensure a clean and plastic free college campus. Campus cleaning, cleaning of adopted villages and literacy campaign are continuous activities of NSS. NSS volunteers are organizing awareness campaign about the importance of Aadhar card, pan card, voter card, bank account, ATM etc time to time and helping the villagers to get them during their special camp, 2022-23.

N.B. For funding regarding, funds came in two heads viz. general activities and special camp from Kazi Nazrul University, Asansol

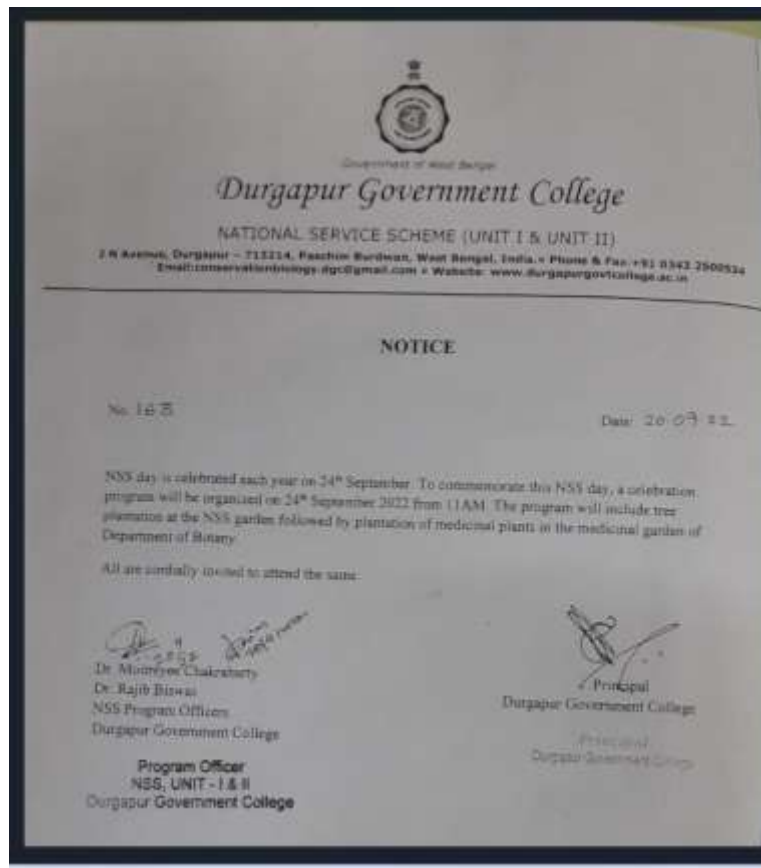
Activities organized by NSS Unit I and II, DGC

NSS Day Celebration

24th September, 2022, 78 NSS Volunteers of Durgapur Government College celebrated NSS Day proudly with Students Association and faculties in our college premises. They organised a beautiful cultural programme. Our Principal Sir, Dr. Debnath Palit and one of our faculty, Dr. Subhojit Ojha inspired NSS volunteers by their valuable talk. Several ex-volunteers participated in the program and shared their own experience of being a volunteer and focussed on the theme and slogan of NSS, 'Not Me but You'.

The inaugural program was followed by planting of medicinal plants at the Medicinal plant Garden of Department of Botany of Durgapur Government College.





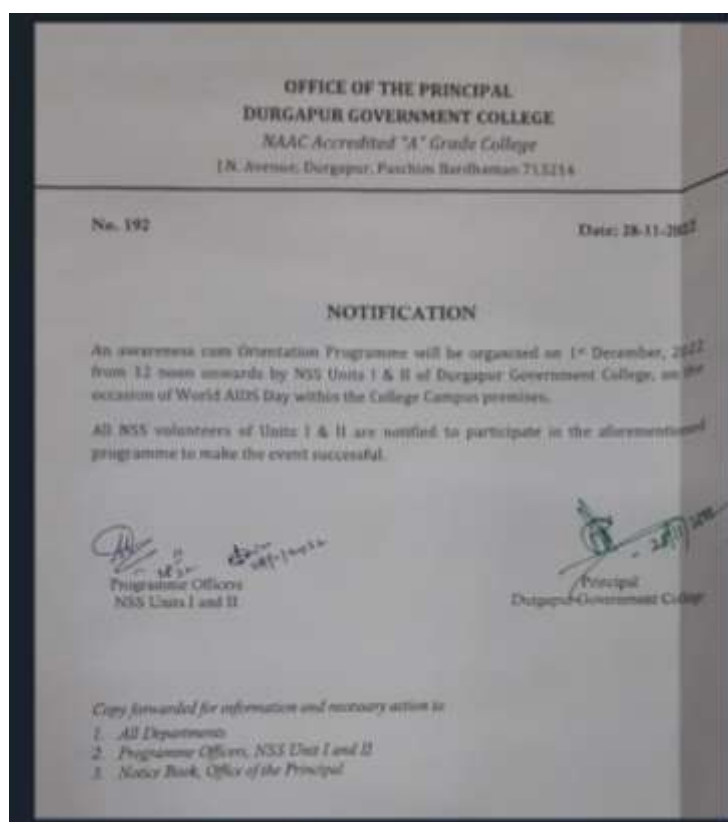
Volunteer's admission Drive

An initiative was taken by NSS Unit I and II to recruit new volunteers from semester I. this volunteer drive was carried out from 9th to 16th November, 2022. A total of 30 NSS volunteers visited different departments for 7 days and collected new names through admission drive. They admitted 80 volunteers through different interaction with newly admitted students in semester I of each Department.



World AIDS Day Awareness Programme

1st December, 2022, 59 NSS volunteers divided in five small groups to aware the college students, villagers and Auto drivers regarding the AIDS, prohibition and prevention of HIV/AIDS by given red ribbon. They use the slogan – “keep the AIDS away and sympathise with diseased anyway”. Volunteers also wear a red ribbon, universal symbol of awareness.



NSS special camp 2022-23

NSS Unit-I &II organised a 7 days special camp within the college premises and day activity in both adopted villages. The special camp started on 3rd April, 2023. The camp started with hoisting of NSS flag maintaining the camp protocol of NSS directive of Central Government. It was followed by an inaugural program where we had Dr. Sachidananda Roy, NSS programme officer, Bankura Christian College as guest of honour, he gave an inspiring and appreciating lecture on the different activities of NSS followed by welcome address of our Principal Sir, Dr. Debnath Palit. Ex Program Officer Shri Nazrul Mallick also graced the occasion and shared his experiences with the volunteers. The program ended with tree plantation and orientation of the volunteers about camp activities for the coming six days.

The volunteers had a daily routine to be followed everyday starting with hoisting of their flag, followed by physical exercise or yoga. Breakfast, lunch and tiffin was made by the volunteers on roster basis along with kitchen and cleaning duties. These are the aspects of NSS special camp which teaches the students to be self sufficient and also learn different co-operative activities. On 4th April, a special sanitation and hygiene program to sensitize the women about using sanitary pads was conducted in Jharna Pally. Free napkins were also distributed and chocolates to all children in Kaligunj, followed by awareness activity and survey at the adopted village. Volunteers were divided into teams for this. During the afternoon session, a pidilite workshop was arranged on handicraft making.

Day 3 had long activities at the adopted villages which included interaction with children and women of the village followed by pidilite workshop in afternoon.

On day 4, similar schedule was followed in morning and in afternoon we had a special lecture delivered by Smt. Swatikana Mondal, Program Officer, MMMC College, Durgapur

Day 5 had normal activities like drawing and teaching with village children, followed by Handicraft and jewellery making. We had Puspita Chakraborty an ex-student having her own online jewellery page who inspired several other students for the same. The day ended with an awareness lecture by Prof. T.K. Saha, Professor, Department of Electrical Engineering, NIT, Durgapur who provided a mesmerising talk on climate change.

Day 8 had village activities and a drawing competition for the village children were organized.

This special camp ended on 9th April, 2023 with a closing ceremony, certificate distribution to ex volunteers and camp fire.
