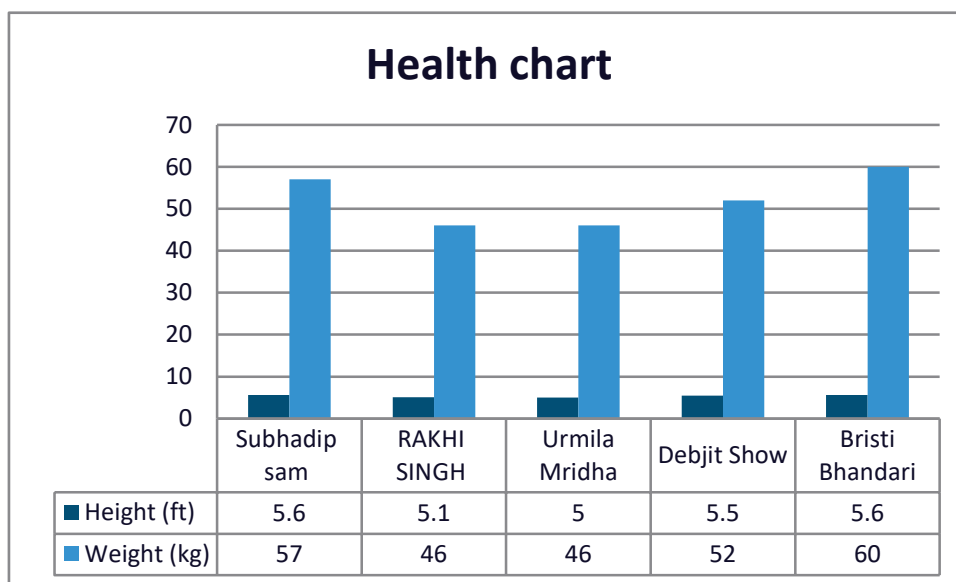


Fig 1: Health chart of mentee

- Health chart of all students were collected for medical purpose (Fig 1)

- Encouragement was provided to pursue further studies

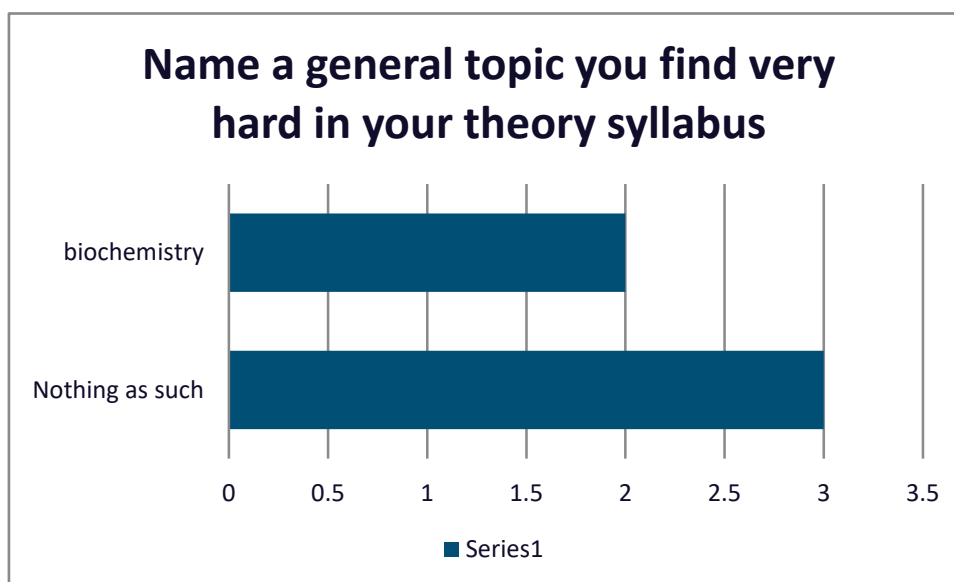


Fig 2: Count of Name a general topic you find very hard in your theory syllabus

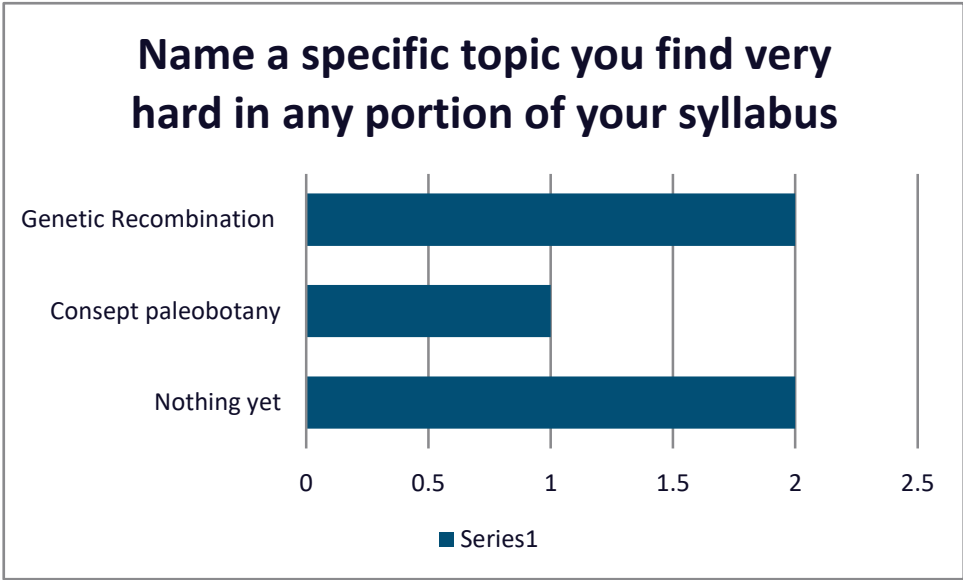


Fig 3: Count of Name a specific topic you find very hard in any portion of your syllabus

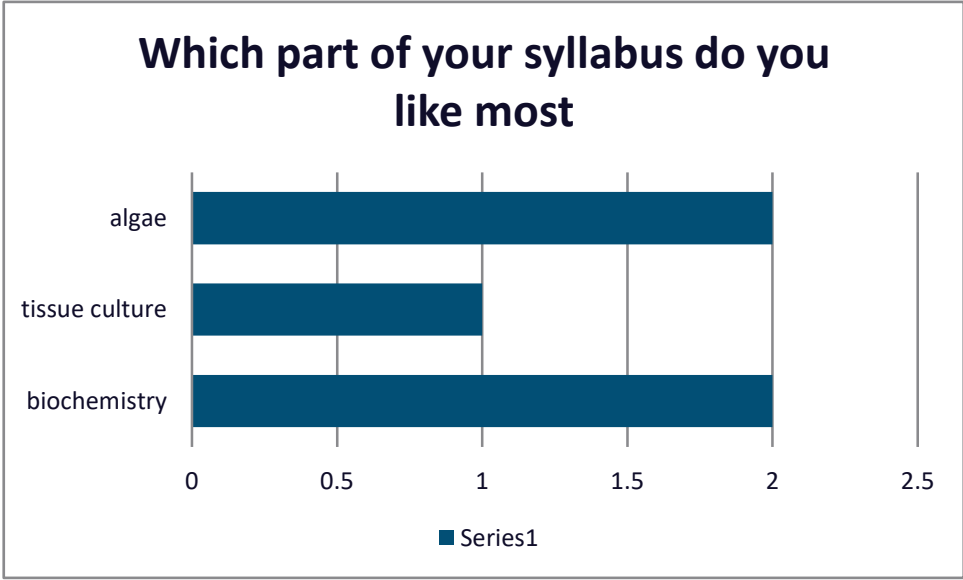


Fig 4: Count of Which part of your syllabus do you like most

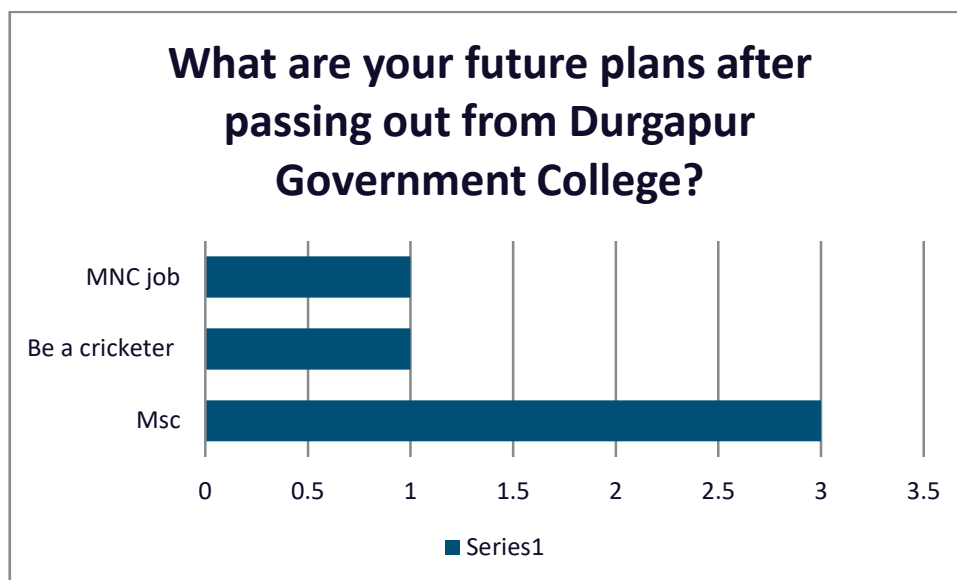


Fig 5: What are your future plans after passing out from Durgapur Government College?

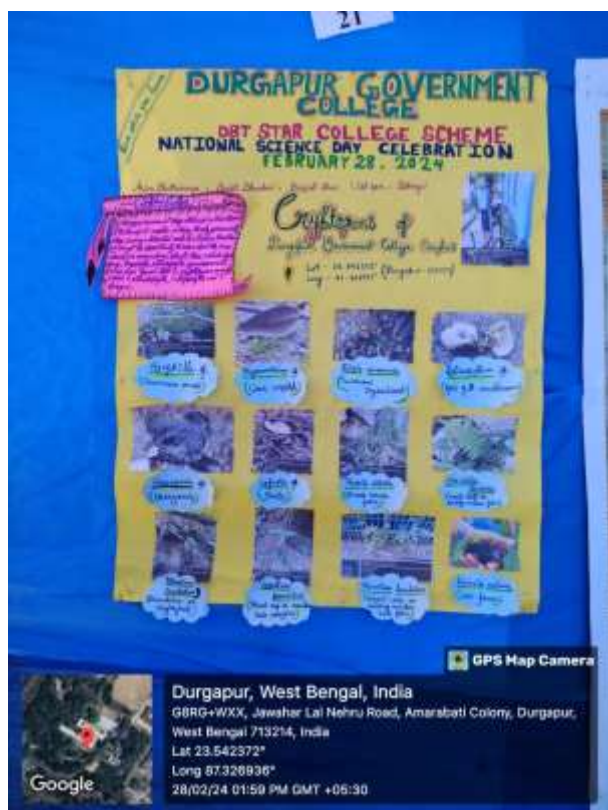
- It was found that most of the students are facing difficulties in studying advanced topic of the syllabus while two of the students found biochemistry interesting
