**The institution assesses the learning levels of the students and organizes special Programmes for advanced learners and slow learners (2023-2024)**

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## ***Assessing the learning levels of the students and initiatives/events organized for slow and advanced learners (2023-24)***

- **Conventional and unconventional ways adopted to assess the learning level of students:** The conventional ways of assessment include written and oral tests, evaluation of assignments submitted in the form of answers, projects, short dissertations and, PPT. The learning-related queries from students, their verbal and non-verbal responses in class, the areas which a student identifies as 'confusing' are indicators of the level of understanding of each student. The feedback, both written and oral, and formal and informal, helps in gauging the learning level of students. The participation of students in interactive sessions and the books that they refer to while working on an assignment indicate the learning ability of students. The unconventional methods include acquiring background information about the student and her/his family to understand whether any economic, cultural, physical health and, emotional issues are directly or indirectly impacting her/his academic performance or participations in learning-related activities. One-to-one talks, discussions in very small groups are also organised to assess learning levels. Problems, where detected, are addressed to the best of one's ability and as far as practicable. Internal assessments were taken from time to time to measure the effectiveness of the teaching techniques used in the class by linking student performance to specific learning objectives. Special care was offered to students facing difficulties and challenges in learning by making them write answers. These answers were evaluated and feedback for improvement was offered periodically. Personalized care was provided by the teachers in their respective mentoring group. Advanced learners were given special attention as well.
- **Learning goal rubric** was set by departments to evaluate Internal and Continuous assessment of students on the basis of i) significance of content delivered ii) clarity of thought iii) alignment with at least state or local standards. Three Indicators were set: a) Indicator Not Met b) Indicator Partially Met c) Indicator Met
- **Interactive Program with students to assess their learning levels are conducted by departments through effective mentoring system**
- **Parent-Teacher Meetings** conducted by departments to individually discuss and address the issues related to slow and advanced learners
- **Orientation Programme and special programs organized by Departments to assess the learning levels:**
- **Student Seminar organized to assess the learning levels of students:** The learning levels of students are assessed while presenting in the student seminar and during role play as teacher. Slow learners are provided with extra classes to help them cope up with the study while all students are encouraged to participate in different expert lectures and events., and also perform experiments beyond the course curriculum, which will be helpful for them in higher studies.



## ***Assessing the learning levels of the students and initiatives/events organized for slow and advanced learners (2023-24)***

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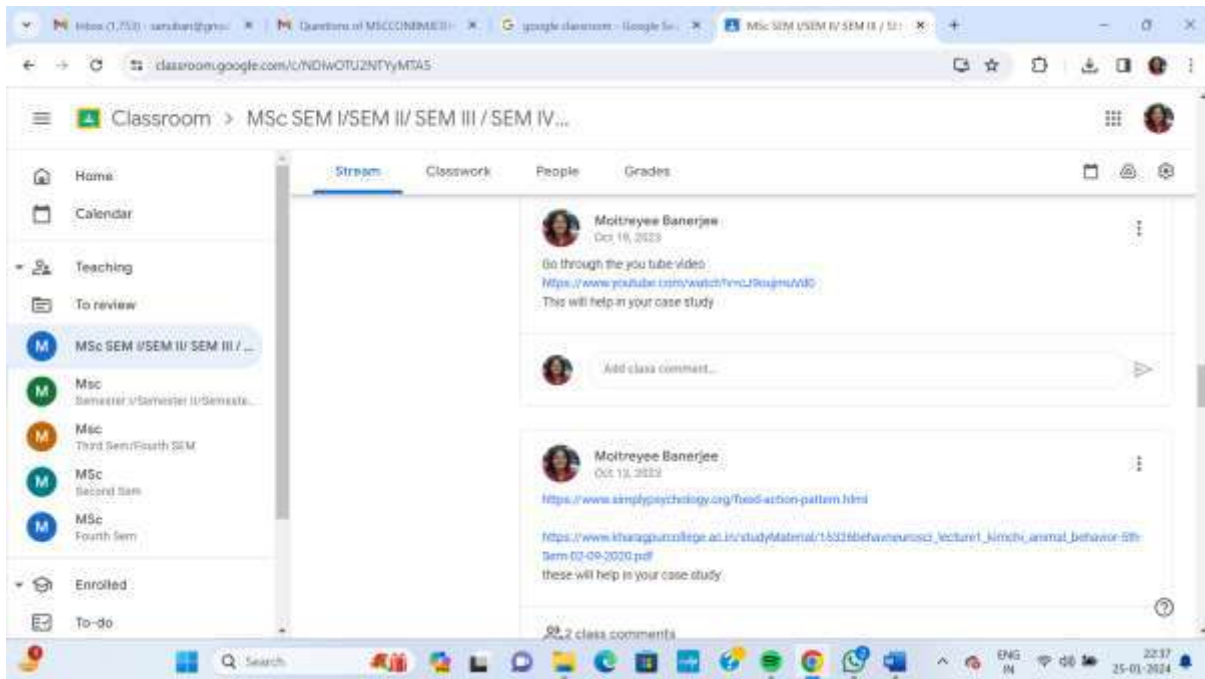
- **Careful and Consistent monitoring of the students' performance in evaluative and non-evaluative assessments to assess the learning levels:** Progress of students are carefully and consistently observed by the faculty members by evaluative and non-evaluative assessments conducted through different modes, such as home assignments, Google form examinations, viva-voce, students' webinars and examination in form of conceptual riddles. Regular, formal and informal meetings are conducted among teachers in which the learning levels of students were discussed. All students' mentors take sincere initiative to communicate with respective student and try to support them.
- **Activities conducted for Slow and advance learners by different departments:**

### **Learner assessment by departments**

- Departments use different learning tools to assess the learning levels of the students.
- To evaluate the learning ability of the students, question answer session is carried out during classes.
- Video tutorials were provided to students and reports and assignments are given to them as homework. It helps to know the capability of each student and their level of performance. Based on this teachers try to identify the slow learners and then take different measures to address their problems.
- Group study is generally encouraged and groups are formed in a combination of slow and advanced learners so that dissemination of knowledge is possible. This also helps to create a healthy and friendly study environment which helps the slow learners to cope with their difficulties.
- Special extra tutorial classes are arranged for slow learners to enable them to overcome their difficulties.
- Group discussions are also arranged after a particular module is completed if and when a slow learner needs special attention to understand a particular lecture/course.

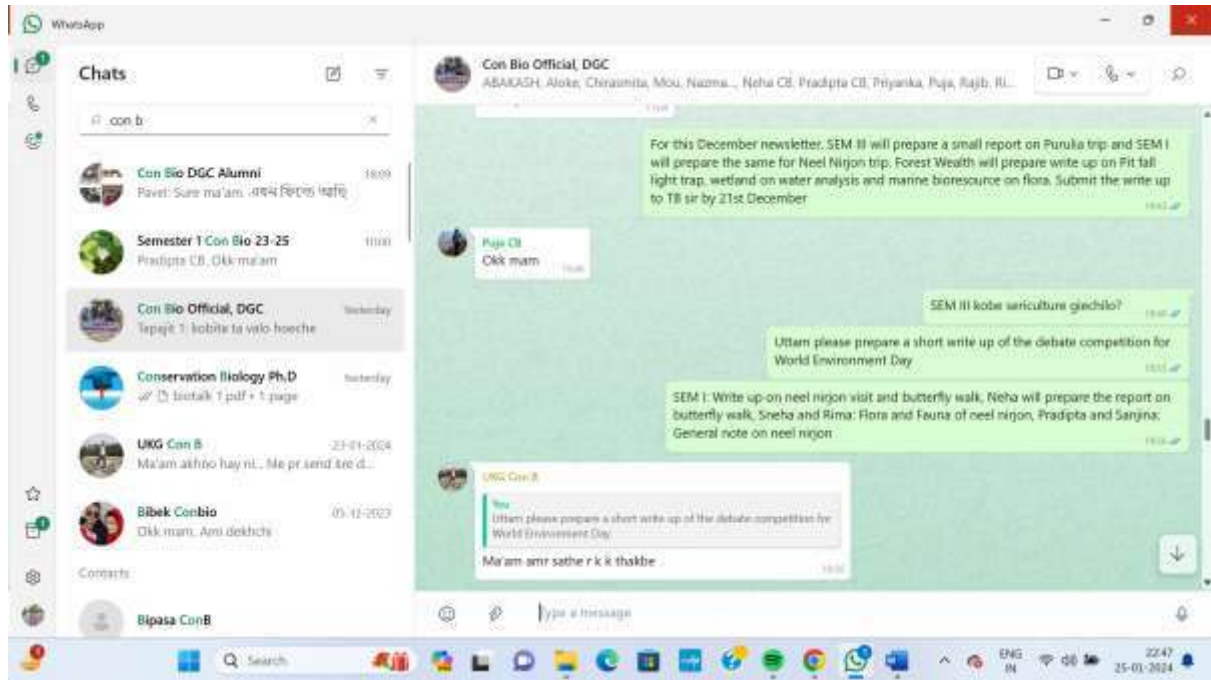
## ***Assessing the learning levels of the students and initiatives/events organized for slow and advanced learners (2023-24)***

- Sometimes conference calls are also made to address the need of the slow learners. Suggestions and advice over telephone is provided on methods by which they can overcome their problems. They are provided with guidance on how to write answers, prepare reports/assignments and suggestions are provided to those who are slow learners in language. Once a student is identified, separate system is provided in order to help the student overcome its problem.

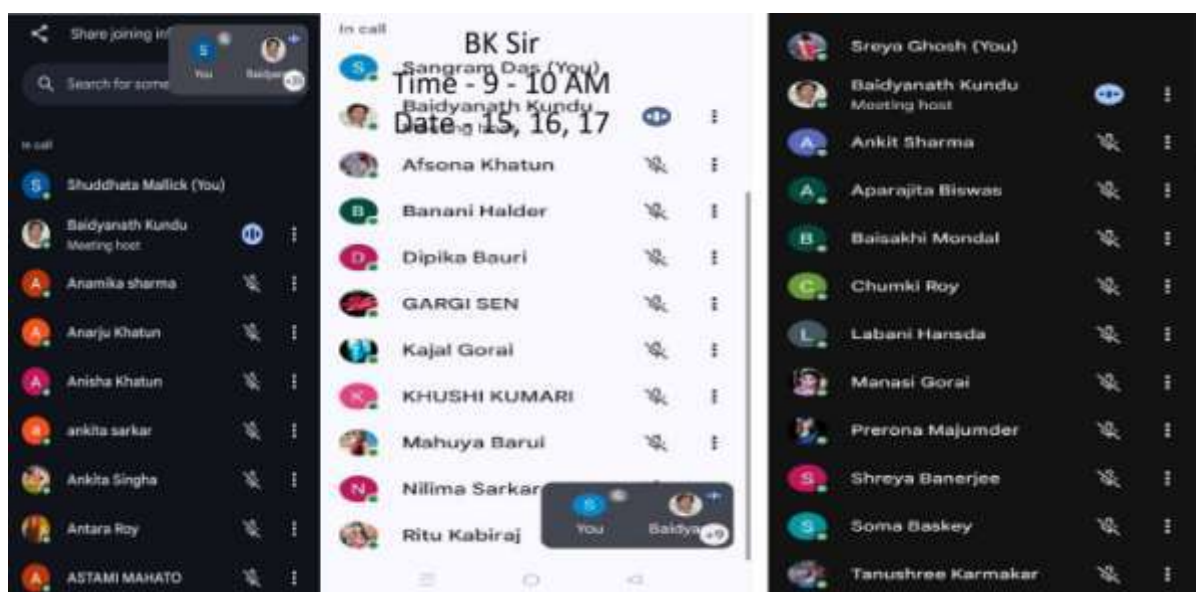


Image: Students attendance during the remedial classes held on 15<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> May, 2024.

- The feedback received from the students reflected positive response with regards to the efficacy of extra lectures in offering better understanding of the topics taught in class.

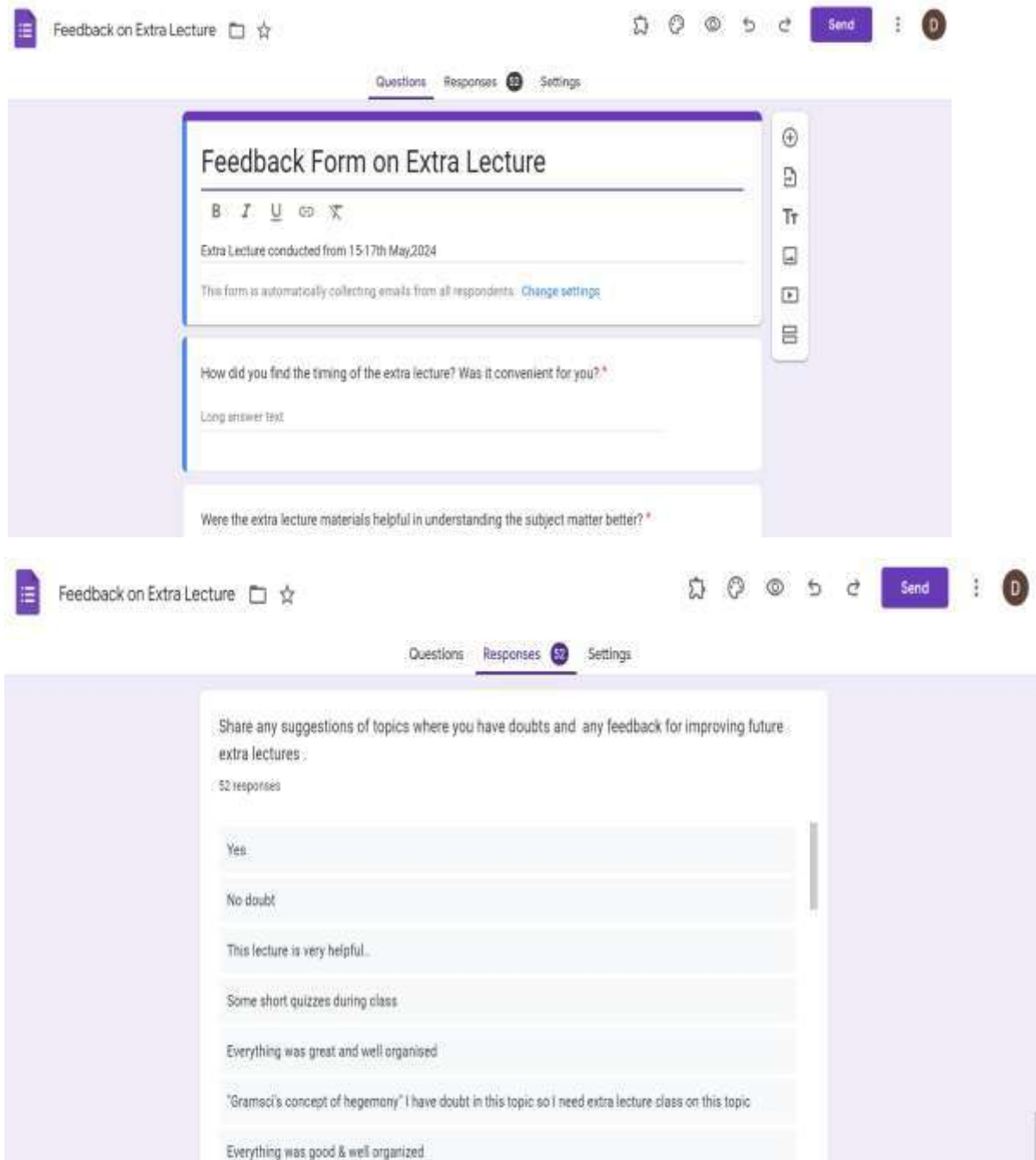


Image: Screenshot of the feedback received from the students

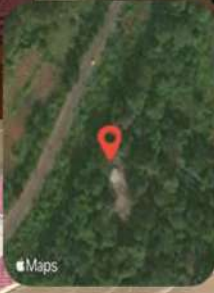

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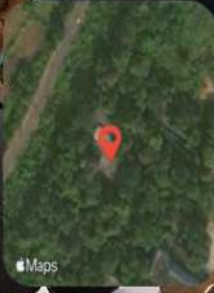

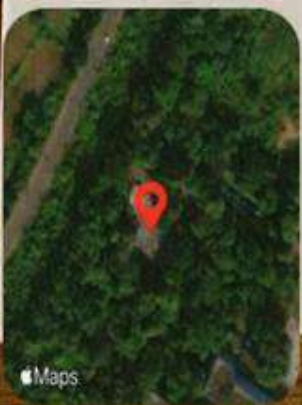

- Permission/Document-related prep

Ankit : Necessary medicines and appropriate dresses

Dhruba : Listing and gathering of items to be used in field  
- Necessary training on how to use the relevant items  
- Knowing about the geol. geography, flora, fauna etc. of the field area through study of relevant literature.

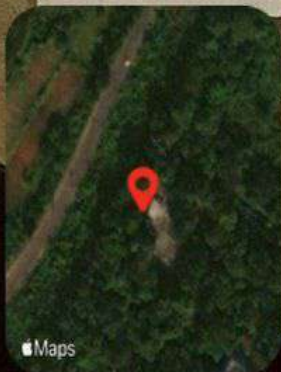
3. Third topic : What items of work are carried out in the main ~~phase~~ field-work phase?

Shreya : She highlighted several specifics, but the major and general work items are to be discussed.

Smigdha : Rock structure recognition, measurement of their orientation and recording in field note book

Suchi Smita : Lithology recognition and locating their position and extent on the base map, specimen collection etc.

Dhruba : Because this is the most crucial phase, our objective remains to utilise our time and energy in the most prudent possible manner during the fieldwork session. So, we study and map lithology, etc. measurements, samples etc. with a view to understanding.



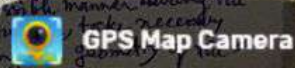

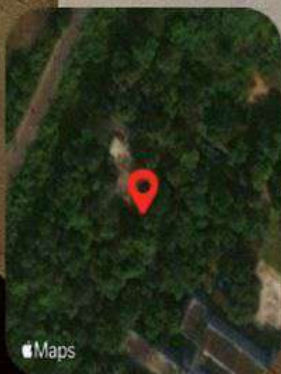
4th or final topic: Comment on the requirements of the final phase (post-fieldwork)

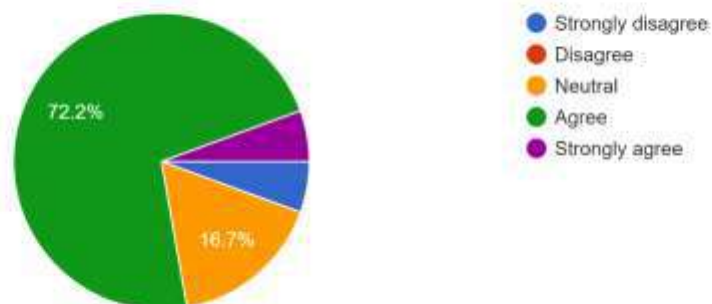

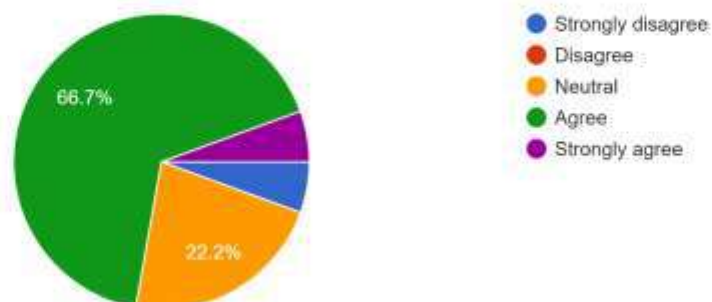

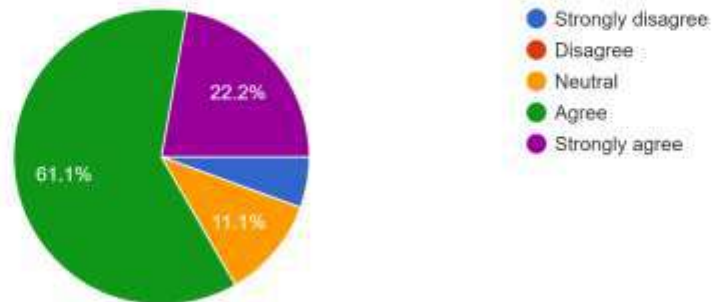

students struggling with certain topics. Especially guardian of one second semester student also request for hostel facility as her home town is Midnapore.

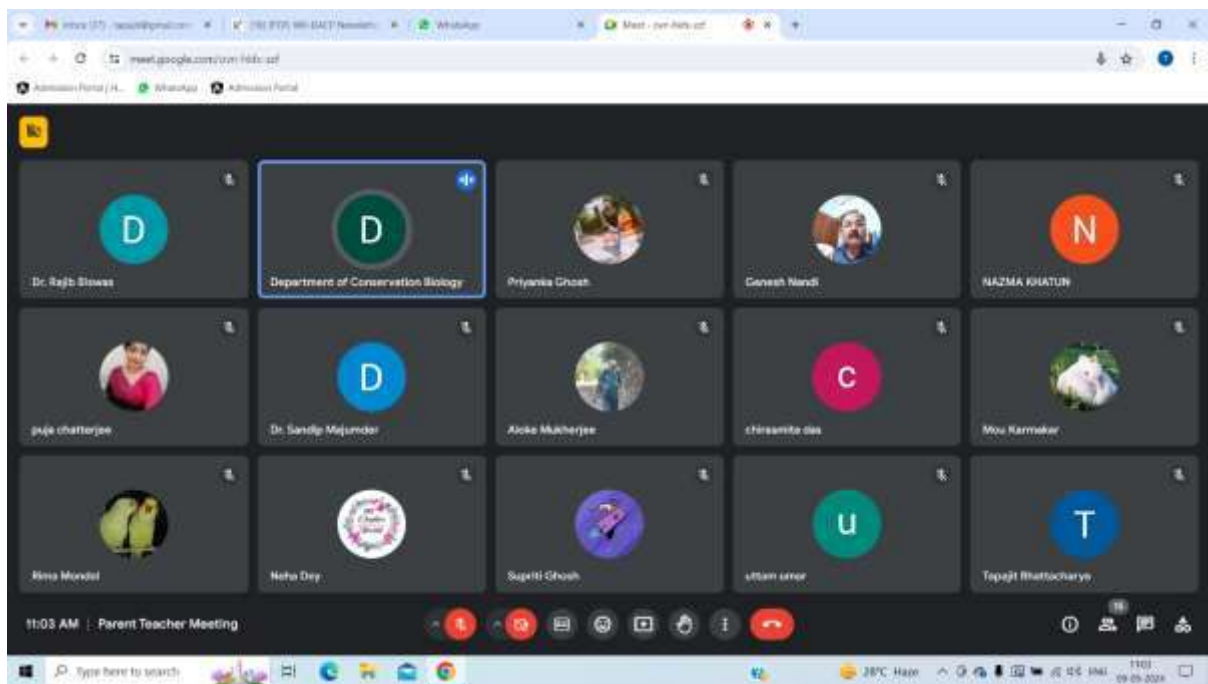
### Action Points

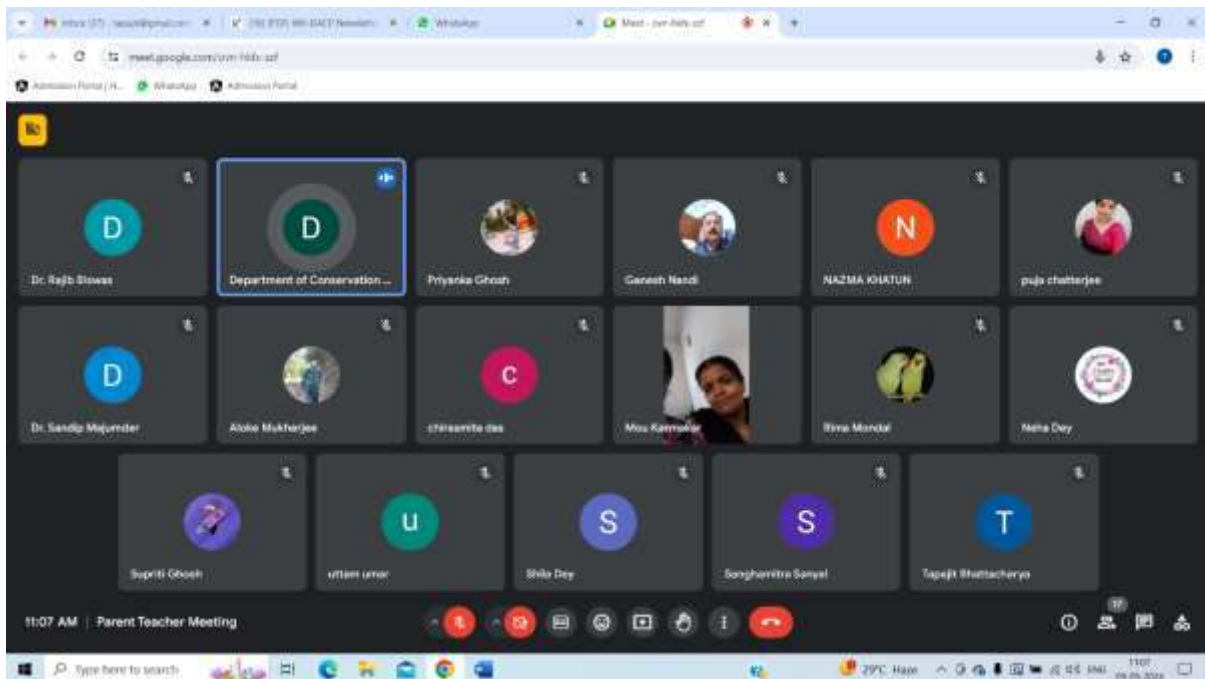
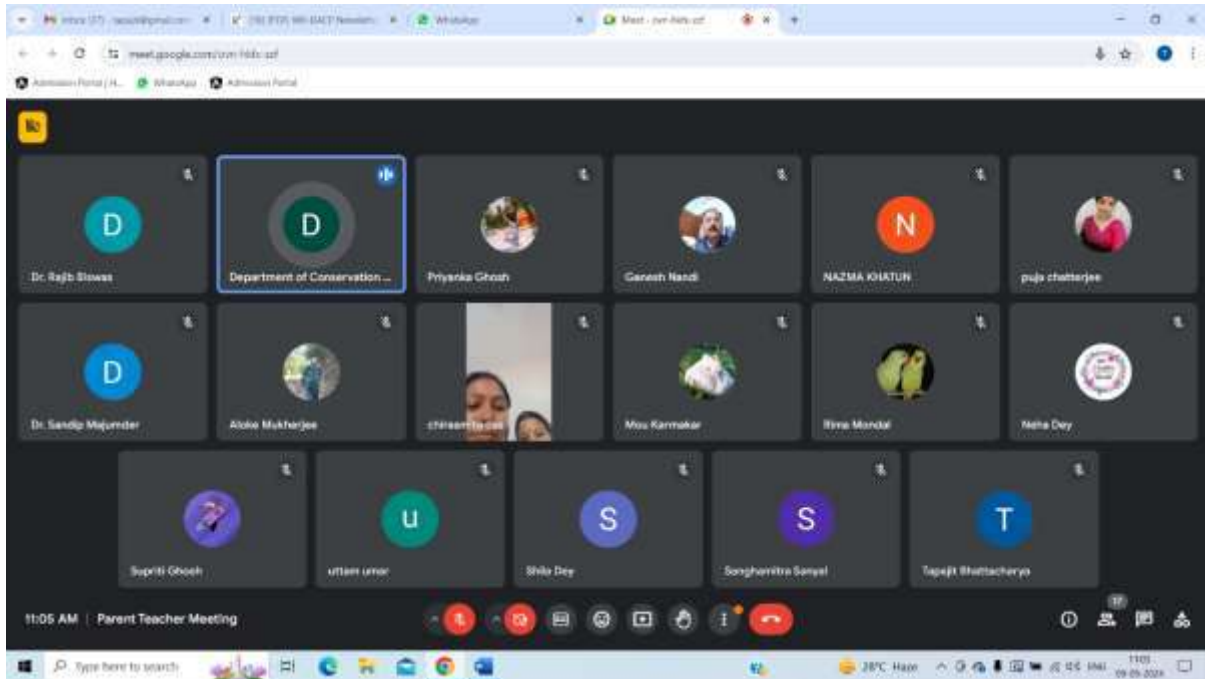
### Conclusion

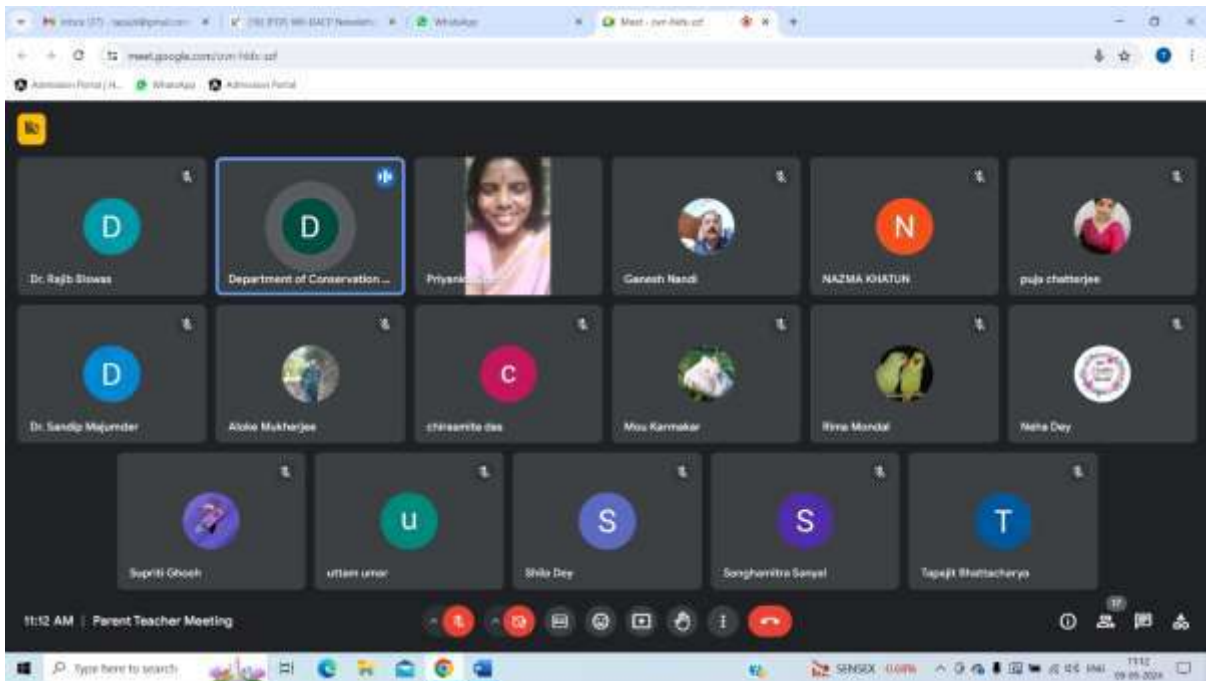
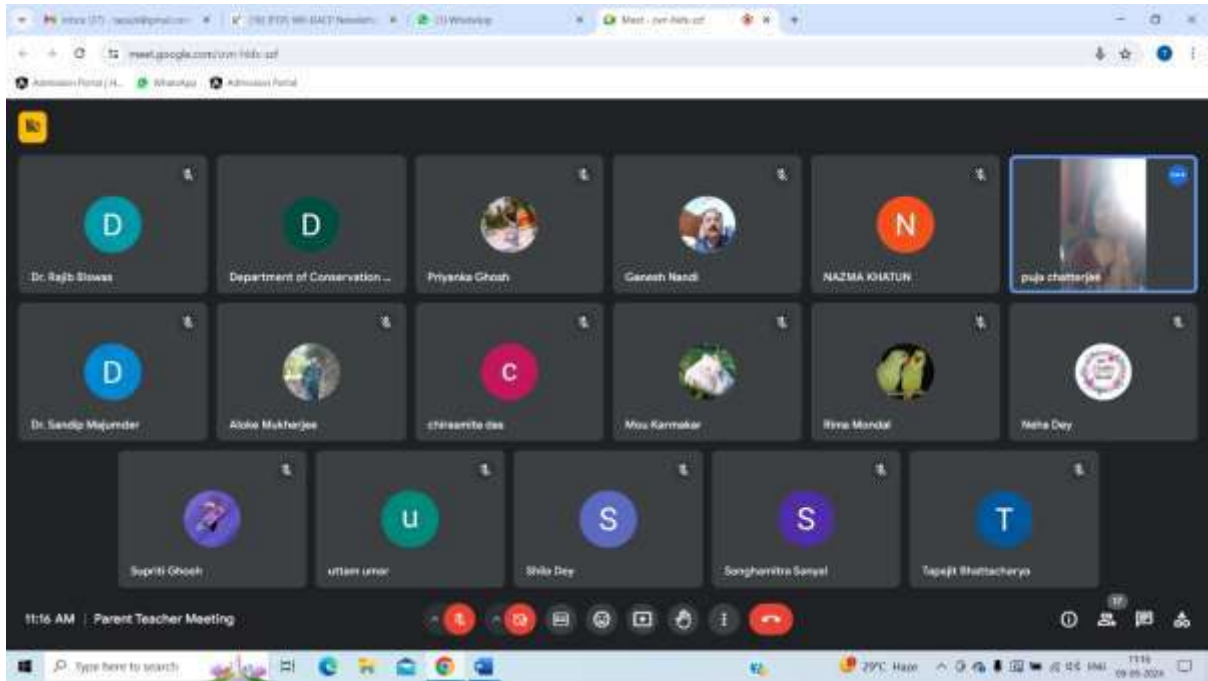

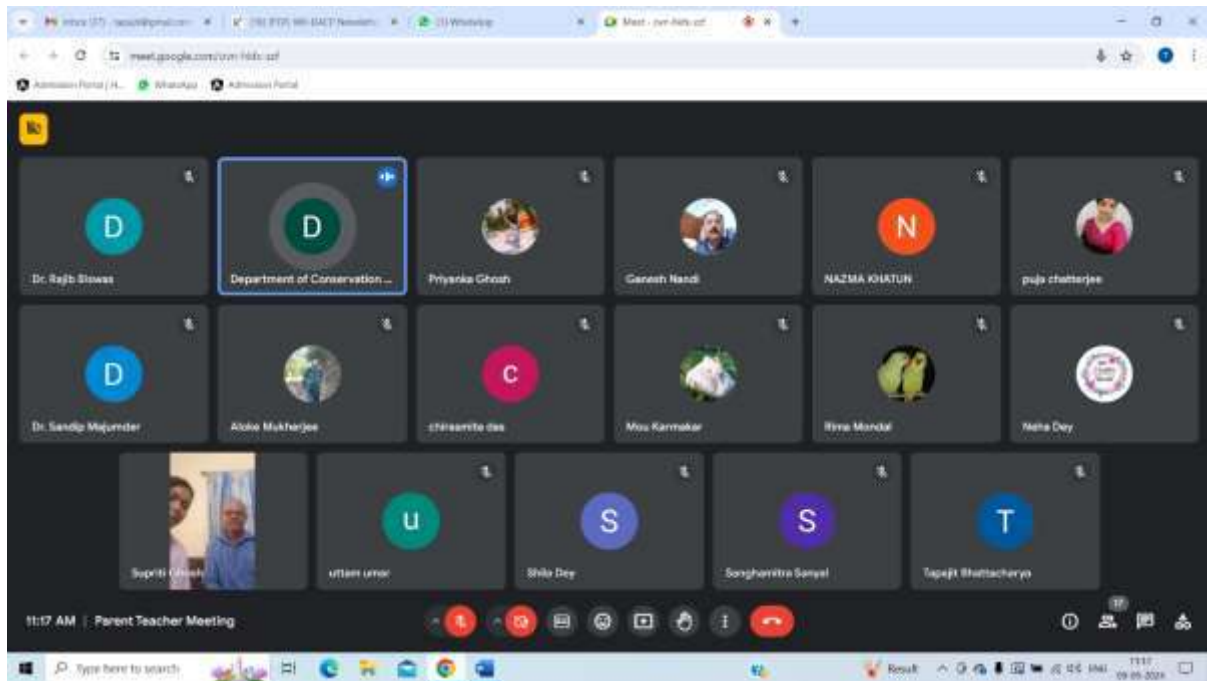
Overall, the Parent-Teachers Meeting was a successful event that helped in strengthening the bond between the parents and the faculty, and it paved the way for the holistic development of the students.









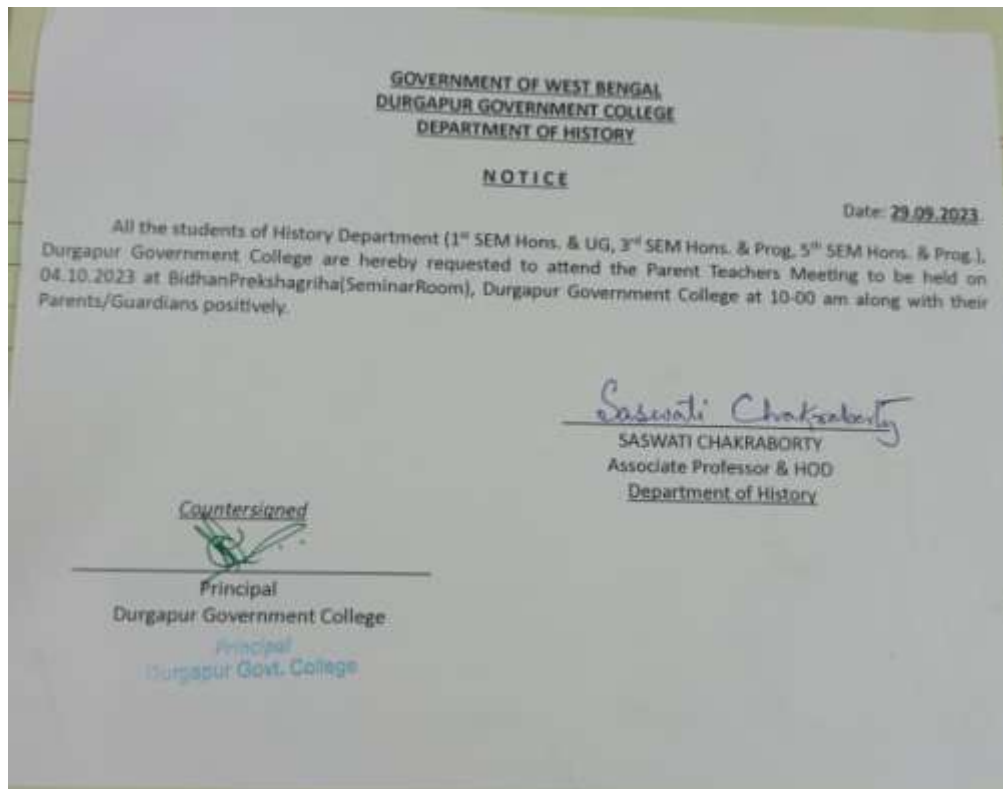




## Report of the Parent –Teacher Meeting






