



#### EXPLORATION CALL MADE BY DR. BHUMIKA KANJILAL WITH ANNA SCHAFFNER; COACH AND WRITER

There was an exploration call with Anna Schaffner and we discussed about what works and what doesn't work for in case of exhaustion on burn out problems in ones work place; such as relationships with colleagues and meeting deadlines and also feeling stuck and exhausted. We discussed on how fatigue affects the mental health in workplace and how efforts are required in building solidarity and agreement on issues. Anna prescribed that a good way forward might be to adopt a more Stoic approach to challenges - to focus on what one may control responses, expectations, inner life and judgements), and learn to cope with it better and not waste too much energy on trying to change external factors.


